* In 2021, our Cold Weather Shelter received a generous gift from Glen Cambre & Associates who had heard about the good work the shelter was doing for the community. That gift, together with additional unsolicited donations from the community, and additional donations from the congregation was in excess of \$10,000. The gift allowed the ministry to purchase and install a shower and a washer/dryer in the Activities Center. The washer/dryer is designated to wash the bedding and linens from the shelter, and the shower can be used by the homeless when the shelter is open

** Tucker First missions sponsored a large contingent of Tucker First members for our Honduras Missions Trip in November 2022. However, each of the team members contributed funds equal to the cost of his or her travel so none of the available scholarship funds were used. Though team members contributed more than \$7,000 to make this mission outreach happen, only \$1,100 in funds from the Faith Promise funds were used.
