<u>Preschool Lead Teacher</u> We need a Lead Teacher in our 3-year-old, 5-day preschool class. Monday thru Friday, 8:30 am – 1:30 pm, plus once a month staff meeting. Hourly, part-time position. Applicants should have a Christian character, love for children and a strong commitment to teaching. This person would also provide the best possible learning environment for children and work for the best interests of the Preschool. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age, have a high school diploma or equivalent and at least two years qualifying childcare experience. Applicant must be able to meet the physical demands of working with young children.

<u>Nursery Attendants</u> We have immediate openings for Nursery Attendants on Sunday mornings, Tuesday evenings and potentially for other dates as scheduled. They should be at least 18 years of age with prior experience caring for young children – ages 6 months to 5 years and able to meet the physical demands of working with young children, including lifting up to 35 pounds. Hourly, part-time position.

<u>Nursery Coordinator</u> This person is responsible for supervising the Nursery Attendants on Sunday mornings and assisting with children as needed, entering attendance records, scheduling workers for events, greeting parents and children on Sunday mornings and assisting with directing visitors to appropriate locations in the facility. Applicant should be a person of Christian character and should excel at interpersonal relations, be friendly and engaging. They should be at least 18 years of age and able to meet the physical demands of working with young children, including lifting up to 35 pounds. Hourly, part-time position.
